The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.16 dated 02.03.2012, registered under Sections 186, 307, 353, 427 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, at P.S. Sadar Kapurthala.

Heard.

On 28.09.2016, the following order was passed (corrected vide order dated 07.10.2016, passed in IOIN-CRM-M-34586-2016):-

“Learned counsel contends that the main accused, namely, Hardev Singh and Sandeep Singh @ Seepa who had allegedly tried to crush the police party stand acquitted of the charges. The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender and has now been summoned under Section 319 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Notice of motion for 16.11.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- 2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
- 3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 28.09.2016 (corrected vide order dated 07.10.2016, passed in IOIN-CRM-M-34586-2016), is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
