Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail on behalf of the accused-petitioner in case FIR No. 143, dated 05.08.2012, for offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 324, 325, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Chabal, District Tarn Taran.

As per allegations, the petitioner alongwith his co-accused entered the shop of the complainant at night. The petitioner is alleged to have fired a shot towards the complainant, who saved himself by ducking. Co-accused/non-applicant-Akul Kumar is attributed two *kirpan* blows, which hit one on the head and other on the leg of complainant.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 19.01.2013 and out of fourteen prosecution witnesses, none has been examined. It is further stated that on 15.01.2016, a compromise has been arrived at with the complainant-Bikramjit Singh, however, the same is neither before the trial Court nor with the police authorities.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition, so as to first file fresh petition for quashing.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
