By way of present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.294 dated 17.08.2016, registered under Sections 307, 341, 323, 427 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station City Sangrur (Punjab).

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that no grievous injury has been caused to the complainant.

Heard.

The allegations in brief against the petitioner are that he along with 9-10 other co-accused had given iron rod blow on the right side of forehead of complainant Sanjiv Virah who is a Head Constable in Punjab Police, CIA Staff, Bahadur Singh Wala, District Sangrur.

The petitioner had caused injury to Police officer/official on his forehead. The injury is serious in nature which endangered the life of the

complainant. Otherwise also, the injury had been given to the police officer, which prima facie shows that the petitioner has no respect for the law and he does not deserve any leniency. Releasing the petitioner on bail at this stage, may hamper the smooth investigation.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
