Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Vide order dated 05.08.2016 (Annexure P-3), Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, in exercise of power under Section 319 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, issued accused summon to the petitioner. The accused summon was issued to the petitioner on the strength of evidence of ASI Balwinder Singh-PW7 before the Court who stated that the person who had stolen the Basmati 1121 bags disclosed to him that it was the petitioner who received the said stolen property from him. It is on that basis, the trial Court has issued accused summon to the petitioner.

In the light of the above discussion, I think the petitioner is entitled to grant of anticipatory bail which is prayed by him in the present petition.

In that view of the matter, petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail on his furnishing bail bonds amounting to

₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
