This order shall dispose of above referred two petitions. For the sake of convenience the facts are being taken from CRM-M-34620 of 2016.

These petitions have been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.407 dated 24.08.2015 registered under Sections 148/149/323/341/302/325 IPC at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that both the petitioners have been in custody for more than one year and none of them has been attributed any injury to the deceased and similarly situated co-accused Sonu and Sukhdeep @ Sukha have been granted regular bail vide orders passed in 12.07.2016 and 02.09.2016 passed in CRM-M-9531 of 2016 and CRM-M-29684 of 2015.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Baljeet Singh has very fairly accepted these factual assertions.

I see no reason to take a different view.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Both the petitions stand allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
