INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.417 dated 30.08.2015, registered
at Police Station Bhuna, under Sections 307, 452 and 34 IPC and
Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Vikas Chopra, learned Deputy
Advocate General, Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the
respondent-State and contested this petition. Police record is also
available.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that as per the version of prosecution, complainant along with his daughter and daughter-in-law was purchasing clothes in a shop where a young boy came from outside and caught hold Bajrangi, owner of the shop, from the neck. When they stood to save him, one of two boys, who were sitting on the motor-cycle outside the shop, fired a gunshot which hit on Sita Devi, daughter of complainant. The present petitioner is stated to be driving the motor-cycle. The motor-cycle has also been recovered.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that if the petitioner is released on bail, he may tamper with the evidence and put pressure upon the witnesses, therefore, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of regular bail.

Dismissed.
