JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner, namely, Arandeep Singh @ Sunny has sought bail in case bearing FIR No.16 dated 28.03.2016, under Sections 452, 324, 334 of Indian Penal Code (Section 307 IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur.

At the very outset of the arguments, it has emerged that after conclusion of the investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., has already been presented and the trial Court is seized of the matter. During the pendency of the trial, injured, namely, Harbhajan Singh and Sukhwinder Singh have already been examined but they did not support the version earlier unfolded to the Investigating Officer. As per the case of the petitioner with the intervention of the respectables and relatives, compromise has already been arrived at between the parties which has been reduced into writing. This compromise bears the signatures of the injureds/complainant besides the respectables/relatives. According to the

said compromise, both the parties feels satisfied and do not want to pursue the matter. Moreover, the petitioner was arrested in this case on 31st March, 2016 and since then he is cooling his heals behind the bars.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
