Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Sunil Koul and Chandra Koul in case FIR No.123 dated 30.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 420 of Indian Penal Code and under Sections 18, 19 and 20 of the Transplantation of Human Organs & Tissues Act, 1994 registered with Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

As per the allegations, accused Sunil Koul has got his kidney transplant operation and along with his wife petitioner no.2-Chandra Koul furnished false information regarding the status of the donor.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners have

since joined investigation and as such nothing is to be recovered from them apart from the fact that the petitioner no.1 has been advised complete bed rest.

Learned State Counsel assisted by Mr. Amrik Singh, ADCP, City-II, Jalandhar does not refute the fact that petitioners have joined investigation.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 5th of October, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
