This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8 as private respondents are misusing the process of law and victimizing him on false accusations, threatening and intimidating him and his family members.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. R.P.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 08.09.2016 (Annexure P-4) was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib way back on 08.09.2016 but till date no action has been taken.

Accordingly, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib to look into the grievances of the petitioner unfolded by him in his representation dated 08.09.2016 (Annexure P-4) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
