**A.B. Chaudhari, J.** (Oral):

Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioners in these petitions seek quashing of FIR No.140 dated 27.8.2013, under Sections 328, 148, 149 IPC, PS Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka as also Rapat No.27 dated 28.8.2013 arising out of the above said FIR, on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 28.9.2016, report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Fazilka has been received who has recorded the statements of both the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion. In that view of the matter, these petitions are allowed and the impugned FIR and the Rapat, along with all consequential proceedings, are quashed by way of compounding/ compromise.
