Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.4 dated 7.1.2012, under Sections 325, 323, 34 IPC, PS Muktsar Sadar, District Muktsar on the basis of compounding/compromise. Pursuant to the order dated 28.9.2016, report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib has been received who has recorded the statements of the parties and reported that the compromise has been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion. In that view of the matter, the petition is allowed and the impugned FIR, along with all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/ compromise.
