Petitioner in the capacity as Naib Tehsildar is alleged to have registered sale deeds although the complainant Navdeep Singh had filed an application to the petitioner for not getting the sale deeds registered as he has already entered into an agreement with Kashmir Singh.

With the assistance of learned State counsel, I have gone through the police file. It is not the case of prosecution that there is any restraint order passed by any Court prohibiting the petitioner to execute the sale deeds.

On the instructions of ASI Balwinder Singh, it is informed that the petitioner has joined investigation, pursuant to the interim order dated 29.09.2016. From the nature of the allegations and the circumstances of the present case, it does not appear to be a case where petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

This petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the

arresting officer subject to a condition that he will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner. He will also not leave India without the permission of the trial Court.
