AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.54 dated 25.05.2015, registered at Police Station Sadar Banga, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 21 and 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

On 05.10.2016, this Court passed the following order:-

“Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Damanjit Kaur Walia, Superintendent, Women Jail, Ludhiana, Prison on behalf of State has been filed and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 26.05.2015 and no other case is pending against her.

Learned Deputy Advocate General states that since

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recovery is of commercial quantity it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial and as per him 8 witnesses remain to be examined and in case the petitioner does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 23.12.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) and further seeks an adjournment to place on record the affidavit of SSP SBS Nagar.

Adjourned to 04.11.2016.”

In compliance of said order, short affidavit of Naveen Singla, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, on behalf of respondent(s)-State has been filed stating this fact. Same is taken on record.

In these circumstances, the instant petition is dismissed. However, the learned trial Court is directed to release the petitioner on bail on 23.12.2016 in case the prosecution does not conclude its entire evidence (subject to the accused not obstructing the same).
