By this petition the petitioner has sought directions to the respondents to not harass and victimize the petitioner and to give an advance notice of 10 days before calling the petitioner in the police station as per the provision of Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated

08.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate action on their representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-the DIG, Border Range, Amritsar is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
