By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. petitioner-Gharsa Ram has sought direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Sirsa to conduct an inquiry about the allegations levelled in the representation dated September 10, 2015 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner and subsequent reminder dated May 05, 2016 (Annexure P-6) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law against the private respondents.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only, at this stage.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Parveen Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that though representation dated September 10, 2015 (Annexure P-5) was moved to respondent No.4-Superintendent of Police, Sirsa and thereafter, reminder

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dated May 05, 2016 was also issued, but despite the fact that police did not take any action so far.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.4 - Superintendent of Police, Sirsa (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated September 10, 2015 (Annexure P-5) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
