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A. B. CHAUDHARI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.76 dated 05.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 448, 420, 120-B, 380 & 506 IPC at Police Station SBS Nagar, District Ludhiana, in view of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents/complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 29.09.2016 asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court through District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana. Looking to the report it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and genuine. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioners. Looking to the nature of the offence about the dispute of property, I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed in this case also.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-34869 OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.76 dated 05.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 448, 420, 120-B, 380 & 506 IPC at Police Station SBS Nagar, District Ludhiana, is quashed qua the petitioners along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
