The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.113, dated 5.5.2016, registered under Sections 302, 307, 148, 149, 120-B of the IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Kulwant Singh, Officiating Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar has been filed, as per which the petitioner has been in custody for 4 months and 13 days as on

4.10.2016.

Status report by way of affidavit of Prabhjot Singh, ACP, South Amritsar has also been filed. A perusal of the same reveals that the deceased had a series of cases registered against him. The only allegation against the petitioner is that he had informed about the departure of the deceased from the marriage hall.

In view of the aforesaid facts, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
