This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.580 dated 28.07.2016 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 332, 353, 186, 379-B, 323, 506, 34, 225, 224 IPC at P.S. Sector-55 Faridabd, District Faridabad.

The allegation is that when the police went to the village to arrest wanted criminal Naseem, the petitioner alongwith other persons interfered, caused injury to the police personnel and after the arrest helped Naseem to escape. In this incident, some police

personnel got injury also.

Learned DAG state that even on earlier occasion the present petitioner was involved in some other FIRs. The Additional Sessions Judge Faridabad has dismissed the petition for anticipatory bail on cogent grounds.

I see no reason to take different view.

The petition stands dismissed.
