Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Sandeep Kaur seeking issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to take action on complaint Annexure P-1 filed by her as well as to take action against respondents No.4 and 5 for extending threats to her to withdraw her complaint lodged by her against respondents No.6 to 8.

2. In pursuance of notice of motion issued by this Court, learned State counsel has filed a status report in the shape of an affidavit of Narinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (H), Mansa, which is taken on record.

3. As per status report the matter has been inquired into and

accordingly, FIR No. 79 dated September 14, 2015 has been registered under Section 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station Jhunir against respondents No.6 to 8 and the investigation is in progress. It has further mentioned in the status report that after investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented in the Court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sardulgarh.

4. In view of the afore-said facts and circumstances, instant petition has rendered infructuous and is disposed of, as such.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved, she can have recourse to the other remedies available to her under law.
