Petitioner along with his co-accused Paramjit Singh had allegedly forged a document dated 10.10.2013 indicative of the fact that a sum of Rs.30 lacs, received by the petitioner and his co-accused as earnest money for execution of a sale deed pursuant to an agreement of sale, stood returned.

ASI Baldev Singh present in the Court, informs that the document has been sent to Forensic Science Laboratory for its authenticity.

With the assistance of learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant, I have gone through the police record.

Without entering into the further controversy regarding the authenticity of the alleged forged document, it is sufficient to observe that application for pre-arrest bail filed by co-accused of the petitioner Paramjit Singh has been dismissed by this Court on 28.01.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to satisfy this Court as to how the case of the petitioner could be distinguished from that case of Paramjit Singh.

This petition is dismissed. Interim order dated 20.01.2016 is hereby vacated.
