This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 01.03.2016, registered under Sections 326/323/324/506/34 IPC, at Police Station Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

At the very outset learned Additional Advocate General states that both the parties had a fight and caused injuries to each other.

Section 326 IPC has been attributed to both the parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant is not in a position to deny this fact.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the other party has been granted anticipatory bail. Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh has accepted this fact.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
