Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of direction to official respondents to register FIR under Section 154 Cr.P.C. on the basis of complaint dated 11.06.2015 (Annexure P-2).

2. In response to the issuance of notice of motion, status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Jasdeep Singh Saini PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) has been filed, according to which, FIR No. 159, dated 11.06.2015, under Section 307 IPC as well as under Section 25/27 of the Arms Act has been registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar. Moreover, Major Mohan Deep Singh Virk, who is being suspected as one of the accused, has already been found innocent.

3. In view of the above referred facts, instant petition has

rendered infructuous. As such, it stands disposed of accordingly.

4. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available to him under law including the lodging of a regular complaint in the competent court of jurisdiction.

5. Salary of incharge SIT is ordered to be released, which was attached vide order dated 25.05.2016 passed by this Court.
