JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 30, dated 08.05.2012, under Sections 323/324/425/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated October 07, 2015, report of Id. Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Budhlada, in which, it has been categorically observed that the matter has been compromised between the parties with their free voluntarily, without any pressure or

coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 30, dated 08.05.2012, under Sections 323/324/425/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
