In the circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur is directed to decide the representation dated 20.09.2016 (Annexure P-3), moved by petitioner by passing a speaking order within a

period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order.
