Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to the petitioners to raise all their pleas before the trial court at the appropriate stage. He, however, prays that personal appearance of the petitioners before the trial court may be exempted. This prayer is not opposed by the learned State counsel.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. In case the petitioners move an application for exemption of their personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioners on such terms & conditions, as it deems proper to impose. The petitioners may be allowed to appear through their counsel except on the dates their presence is necessary.
