Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Makhan Singh alleging that his property has been transferred by a registered sale deed dated 10.04.2013 by an impersonator. The sale deed was attested by Municipal Councilor Buta Singh and Municipal Councilor Rajinder Singh. So far as the petitioner is concerned, he is alleged to have signed the self-declaration form of impersonator of Makhan Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted on the last date of hearing that quashing petition on the basis of compromise had been filed but it is informed now that the compromise has not materialized.

With the assistance of learned counsel for the petitioner, learned State counsel and ASI Jagjit Singh, I have gone through the police file and perused the self-declaration form of Makhan Singh which contains

the photograph of fake Makhan Singh. The petitioner has identified said Makhan Singh. It was on the basis of said declaration and identification that a fictitious sale deed had been executed and registered. The petitioner has apparently misused his status as Municipal Councilor.

No extraordinary exceptional circumstances exist to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.

Nothing said in this order will prejudice the right of the petitioner to seek concession of regular bail in accordance with law.
