Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.83, dated 20.11.2014, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Joga, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR. He was arrested and released on bail and that there was no allegation against him. It is further stated that challan has not been presented so far.

It is observed that the mere fact that the name of the petitioner is not mentioned in the FIR is not a ground to quash the FIR in question. During investigation, the police can find out, who is involved in the crime. Therefore, there is no ground to quash the FIR in question.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
