This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 866 dated 08.08.2016 under Sections 323/328/498A/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh Panipat.

As per the MLR, the doctor has simply opined that there was mild epigastric tenderness. The alleged poisonous substance was not of such magnitude to cause any harm to the complainant.

Learned State counsel on instructions has informed the Court that the challan has already been presented on 27.09.2016 and the case is at the stage of framing of charge. The petitioner has been in custody since 07.09.2016.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panipat.
