ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

By this order, I propose to dispose off two petitions seeking regular bail in FIR No. 31 dated 01.03.2016, registered under Sections 376/149 IPC, Sections 3 & 4 of the POCSOO Act and Sections 5 & 9 of the Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, District Bathinda. One petition has been filed by Deepu @ Satnam Singh and the other by Manwinder Kaur @ Mani.

Both the petitioner are in custody since 05.06.2016. The investigation is over, challan has been filed and charge has been framed. The prosecutrix has been examined. Some accused could not be arrested. The allegations against both the petitioners were that they in connivance with the main accused used to send the girl to unknown persons at night.

The State counsel says that there is no other case registered against the petitioners.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
