Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0044 dated 4.4.2016, under Sections 406, 419 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states in the FIR the allegation against the petitioner is that the complainant deposited a sum of Rs.14,000/- in the account of the petitioner and the petitioner has projected himself as an Income Tax Officer. He further states that for the amount, as alleged in the FIR, he has prepared a bank draft and states that he will hand over the original draft to the Investigating Officer within two days, who shall further hand over the same to the complainant.

In view of the aforesaid undertaking the present petition is

rendered infructuous.

Interim order shall continue to have effect upto 6th December, 2016. In case the petitioner fails to deliver the amount on or before the date fixed, the present petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed.
