This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.242 dated 07.08.2016 registered under Sections 186/323/333/353/307/109/34 IPC at Police Station, Chandhat, District Palwal.

As per the allegation the complainant was driven on a government ladies bus and had recently been posted on the new route from Palwal to Amarpur. On the fateful day when he was doing his duty two boys on the motorcycle came and threw bricks at the bus which hit him on the head and as a result of that there was an accident and many passengers suffered injuries.

As per the complainant this was done at the behest of two private bus owners who were earlier having monopoly on that route.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have been in custody since 07.08.2016 and the invocation of Section 307 IPC is highly debatable.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from Investigating Officer has accepted this fact that the petitioners have been in custody since 07.08.2016.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioners on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
