Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 0102 dated 06.12.2015, under Sections 380, 454, 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar.

As per the allegations levelled by complainant-Ranjit Singh, he was given Flat No.217FF on rent by the present petitioner-Paramjit Kaur, however, said flat belongs to one Sharanjit Kaur, who is in possession. Thus, it is alleged that complainant has been duped.

It was contended that from the facts of the case, no offence against the petitioner is made out.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Baljinder Singh, concedes the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 08.01.2016, is made absolute.
