The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.0019 dated 15.05.2016 registered under Sections 323, 325, 149 & 506 IPC (Section 308 IPC added later on) at Police Station Qila Lal Singh, District Gurdaspur.

The petitioner was arrested on 17.06.2016 and is in jail since then. The challan has already been filed before the concerned Court as stated by learned State counsel.

The assault is made by brick and though it is true that the same was hit on the head but the fact remains that the trial will take its own time and the petitioner is not required to be detained in jail *ad infinitum*.

In that view of the matter the petition for regular bail is allowed.
