Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to register an FIR against respondent No.4 or in the alternative, to decide the representation of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he confines his prayer only to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner. He further states that for the aforesaid relief, the petitioner has submitted a representation (Annexure P-3) which was received in the office of respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar on 1.8.2016.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) and to act in accordance with law.

It is made clear that the claim of the petitioner is restricted only to the life and liberty of the petitioner, if any.
