This is a petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents and further direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 for specific compliance of order dated 28.05.2016 passed by this Court in CRM-M-18108 of 2015 titled as "Amandeep Kaur and Anr. Vs. State of Punjab and Ors.".

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that though various representations including one dated March 09, 2016 (Annexure P-9) was moved to the police authorities, but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authorities. Learned counsel further contends that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka (Punjab) to decide their representation dated March 09, 2016 (Annexure P-9) within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion.

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At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated March 09, 2016 (Annexure P-9) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

However, at the same time petitioners are also directed to cooperate with Investigating Agency pertaining to FIR No.96, dated October 08, 2015, under Sections 448, 427, 506, 109 & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.
