JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused in case FIR No.263 dated 21.12.2014, under Sections 307, 336, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station City, Kotkapura, District Faridkot (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations lodged by the injured/complainant-Loveraj Singh, he was shot at by Lovi Deora and Bhola Shooter with intention to kill him on the right side of his abdomen, left thigh and bicep of the right arm, while they were accompanied by four other non-applicant/co-accused.

It is contended that the name of the petitioner/accused was not nominated by the injured/complainant on whose eye-witness account, the FIR was lodged, however, subsequently, he has been nominated on the statement of the father of injured/complainant by way of supplementary statement with the allegation that the petitioner accompanied the other co-

accused, and as such even in that version, no specific role has been attributed.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Jagdish Singh, is unable to refute the aforesaid factual position and further submits that the challan has been presented.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
