JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer was for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Satnam Singh @ Satta, Ranjit Singh and Jagjit Singh in case FIR No.151 dated 26.12.2015, under Sections 448, 380, 427, 506, 148, 149, 511 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Bajakhana, Distt. Faridkot.

There are allegations that three petitioners along with two other co-accused had demolished the boundary wall of the house of the complainant in an effort to take possession and allegedly also committed theft of Gas Cylinder attached with a Geyser.

Prayer was restricted only qua petitioner Nos.2 and 3 since petitioner No.1 was stated to have been arrested on 30.01.2016. Two other co-accused were also stated to have been arrested.

Accordingly, present petition qua petitioner no.1 was dismissed as having become infructuous.

It was contended that the parties are collateral and in a suit for permanent injunction, possession of the site in question was found to be of accused party.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Mukand Singh, concedes the aforesaid factual submissions.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 01.02.2016, is made absolute.
