Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.35 dated 29.5.2016 under Sections 306/34/120-B IPC registered at Police Station GRP, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 29.5.2016 and he has been booked on the basis of suicide note allegedly written by deceased Rajnish. He further states that in the said suicide note, the deceased had named as many as 18 persons and it has been alleged that the accused have fraudulently obtained cheque from deceased Rajnish.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satwinder

Singh, states that apart from the fact that the custody is too less, the name of petitioner figures in the suicide note written by deceased Rajnish.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Admittedly, the petitioner is in custody since 29.5.2016. The conclusion of trial is likely to take sufficient long time. The allegations made in the suicide note are not of such nature where a person can commit suicide. Even if it is alleged that the petitioner has fraudulently obtained cheque from the deceased, is no ground to commit suicide. Therefore, this Court feels that is a fit case where the petitioner deserves concession of bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

It is made clear that the observations made hereinabove are restricted only for limited purpose of disposal of the present petition for regular bail and shall not construe any expression on the merits of the case.
