Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh has informed the Court that in compliance of the order dated 05.09.2016, he had got the information that petitioner's father have 48 marlas of land in different places and two marlas of land in the name of the mother of the petitioner. As per income tax report, petitioner's gross annual income is Rs.96,870/- per annum and no property/land has been transferred by his father in the name of the petitioner. He further states that some gold articles have been recovered from the father-in-law and mother-in-law of the complainant. The daughter from this marriage is in the custody of the petitioner.

In view of the above, order dated 15.10.2015 whereby, arrest of the petitioner be kept in abeyance is made absolute subject to the provisions under Sections 438 Cr.P.C.
