For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Judgment dated 22.08.2016 passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur is taken on record.

At this juncture, counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was only 12 years old when his sister Mohinder Kaur was supposed to have married with Prakhar Singh, husband of the complainant. The complainant had filed the complaint No. 44 dated 29.11.2008 under Sections 406, 420, 494 and 120-B of the IPC in which Mohinder Kaur, the main accused, stood acquitted by an order dated 22.08.2016. On the basis of the said order, the petitioner herein prays for quashing of the complaint against him as well.

This petition is disposed of by remanding the matter to the Juvenile Court at Hoshiarpur in complaint case No. 44 dated 29.11.2008 with a direction to pass appropriate orders thereunder by noticing the judgment dated 22.08.2016 rendered by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hoshiarpur.
