This order shall dispose of aforesaid two petitions filed by petitioners Jagjit Singh alias Babla and Gurmail Singh under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.35 dated 26.04.2016, registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Ludhiana City, under Sections 382, 342, 323 and 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners state that it is a case of magisterial trial and the petitioners have been in custody for more than 04

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months. He further states that the challan has been presented.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Janak Raj, has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances and the period of custody already undergone by the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

The instant petitions stand allowed.
