This is a petition for the grant of regular bail in case bearing FIR No. 137 dated 04.02.2016, under Sections 332, 353, 186, 307, 427 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurgaon, District Gurgaon.

As per allegations when the police tried to stop the petitioner and his co-accused on the basis of a secret information that they used to indulge in stealing vehicles and snatching, he and his co-accused attempted to escape on the motor cycle which they were riding and rather

fired shots at the police party.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that as a matter of fact the entire case is false and that there was no reason for the petitioner to have tried to escape when the police stopped him. He further argued that no case is pending against the petitioner and on the contrary it was a case where the police indulged in unprovoked firing. The petitioner has been in custody since 04.02.2016.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the present petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Criminal Misc.Application, if any also stands disposed of.
