This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No.562 dated 16.07.2016, under Sections 376, 313 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station, Civil Lines, Karnal, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the statement made by the prosecutrix before the Women Police Station on 07.07.2016, whereby she has stated that she had accompanied the petitioner on her own after taking leave from the Ashram and she had visited Vaishno Devi, Dharamshala and Haridwar. She also stated that the petitioner had visited her *mama's* house at Sector 14, Karnal, as well as her mother. The aforesaid statement was made by the prosecutrix before the Women Police Station, Karnal, whereas the present FIR has now been registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.
