The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.124 dated 07.08.2016 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 & 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was arrested on 24.08.2016 and is in jail since then.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of complainant submits that father of the complainant has mortgaged the property in question with father of the petitioner, who had forged a sale deed dated 30.12.1996 and the present FIR was lodged against him.

In that view of the matter this dispute is entirely civil in nature. Hence, the petition for regular bail is allowed.
