This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.42 dated 20.07.2015 registered under Sections 324/323/506/148/149 IPC at Police Station Mattewal, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the other co- accused Sukhdev Singh @ Shibu Foji has been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 24.08.2016 passed in CRM-M-28164-2016.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh has very fairly accepted these factual assertions.

I see no reason to take a different view.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioners are directed to appear before the investigating officer on 04.11.2016 and on any other date as and when their presence is required. On their appearance the I.O. shall release them on bail to his satisfaction subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. In case the petitioners do not appear before the investigating officer in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
