This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to the petitioners in a case registered against them vide FIR No.263 dated 21.12.2014 under Sections 307/336/506/120-B/148/149 IPC and offences under Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station City, Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Pursuant to order dated May 16, 2016, opinion of the Medical Board constituted at Hospital at Faridkot, has been received. Same has been perused and returned to the State counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been implicated in the case on the charge of conspiracy (Section 120-B IPC). Similarly placed accused namely Binay Deora has already been granted the concession of bail. Petitioners are incarcerated since 29.12.2014 and trial may still take some time to conclude.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for bail.

Heard.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of incarceration of the petitioners, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioners in custody any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot.
