The petitioner was arrested in this case on 22.06.2016 on the strength of statement allegedly made by a co-accused while in police custody. Apart from the aforesaid statement of the co-accused, there is admittedly no other incriminating material against the petitioner, who has remained in detention for almost five months now.

In the circumstances, the petitioner, namely, Ram Mehar s/o Dariya, is directed to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jind, subject to imposition of any other precautionary terms and conditions as he may deem fit.
