The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.214 dated 21.12.2015, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the forged document i.e. the birth certificate of the child, namely, Jaskeerat Singh, pertains to co-accused, Akhtiar Singh. The petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her. Civil litigation between the petitioner and her husband Bhupinder Singh is pending

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adjudication before the civil Courts at Ludhiana. Civil litigation is also pending between co-accused Akhtiar Singh and his wife Parminder Kaur before this Court.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioner has though joined the investigation but is not cooperating.

Heard.

The allegation against the petitioner is that she forged the stamps of the municipal counsellors and used them to prepare a forged birth certificate of the child, Jaskeerat Singh, which are yet to be recovered. The complainant is the son of Akhtiar Singh and Parminder Kaur. The petitioner developed close proximity with Akhtiar Singh, during the subsistence of his first marriage with Parminder Kaur.

Keeping in view the serious allegations and the fact that she is not cooperating in the investigation, no case for grant of pre-arrest bail is made out.

Dismissed.
