This second petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.10 dated 08.01.2016, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 325, 307, 427, 506 and 302 of Indian Penal Code read with Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sector-34, Chandigarh.

Notice of motion was issued in this case and learned State counsel appeared and contested the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The factum of death of the petitioner's father has not been disputed by the respondent-State. It is also evident from the record that the cremation has already taken place and the petitioner wants interim regular bail to perform ritual ceremonies.

Keeping in view above facts and circumstances of the case,

Superintendent, Model Jail, Chandigarh, is directed to produce the petitioner in custody at village Dahola, District Jind on 07.10.2016 from 11:00 a.m. to 04:00 p.m., at the expenses of the petitioner, enabling him to perform ritual ceremonies.

As requested, a copy of this order be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of Bench Secretary.

Registry is also directed to send a copy of this order to the concerned Jail Superintendent, through fax, for compliance.

In view of aforesaid direction, the petition is disposed of.
