Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

Petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 5.10.2010, (Annexure P4), passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patti, vide which, truck bearing registration No.PB-02-Z-9845 was ordered to be released in favour of respondent No.2 Dharam Paul Singh i.e. the registered owner or his S.P.A. Budh Singh respondent No.3. It comes out that respondent No.2 Dharam Paul is the registered owner. If there is agreement between the parties regarding sale of the truck and in consequence thereof, the registration was not transferred, the lower Court was justified in not releasing the truck to third person. Prima facie the registered owner is entitled to *superdari*. No ground is made to interfere in the impugned order.

The petition stands dismissed.
